



To ensure camper safety, Creative Summer requires that campers be picked up by a parent or responsible adult from their afternoon bus stop, unless we are notified in writing that the camper is permitted to walk home from the bus.

To give permission for your camper to walk home from their afternoon bus stop, please fill out the form below and return it to the Creative Summer office. Your camper will not be permitted to leave the bus stop unaccompanied unless this form has been received by the Creative Summer office.

- Campers age 10 and older (Creative Campers Red Group) may walk home unaccompanied.
- Campers age 7 to 9 (Creative Sevens; Creative Campers Orange, Yellow, and Green Groups) may walk home if accompanied by an older sibling age 10 (Red) or older.
- Campers younger than age 7 may not walk home from their bus stop unless accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.
